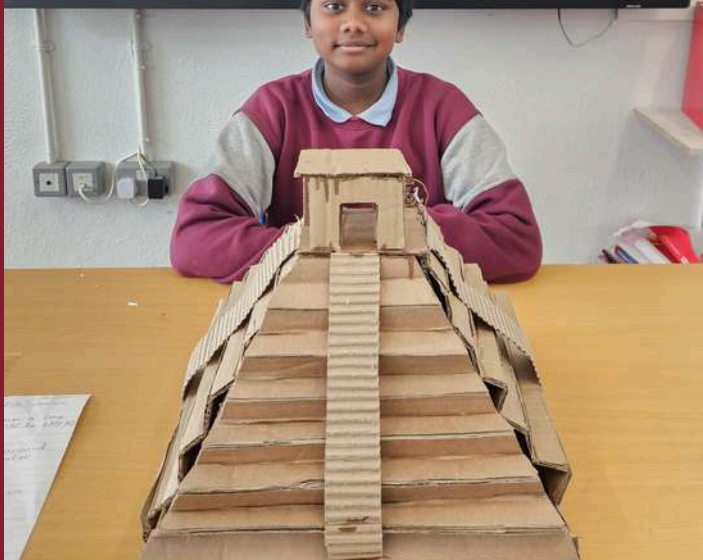
The standard of work was exceptional, with pupils demonstrating excellent research, design and construction skills.
