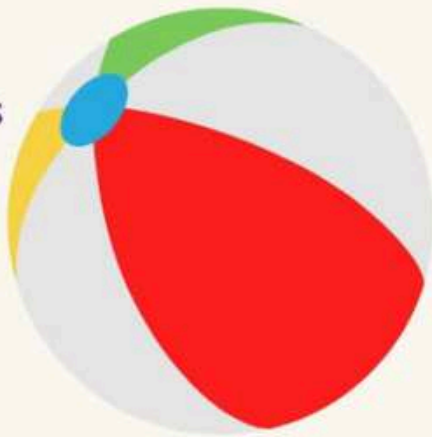

Well done to all involved.

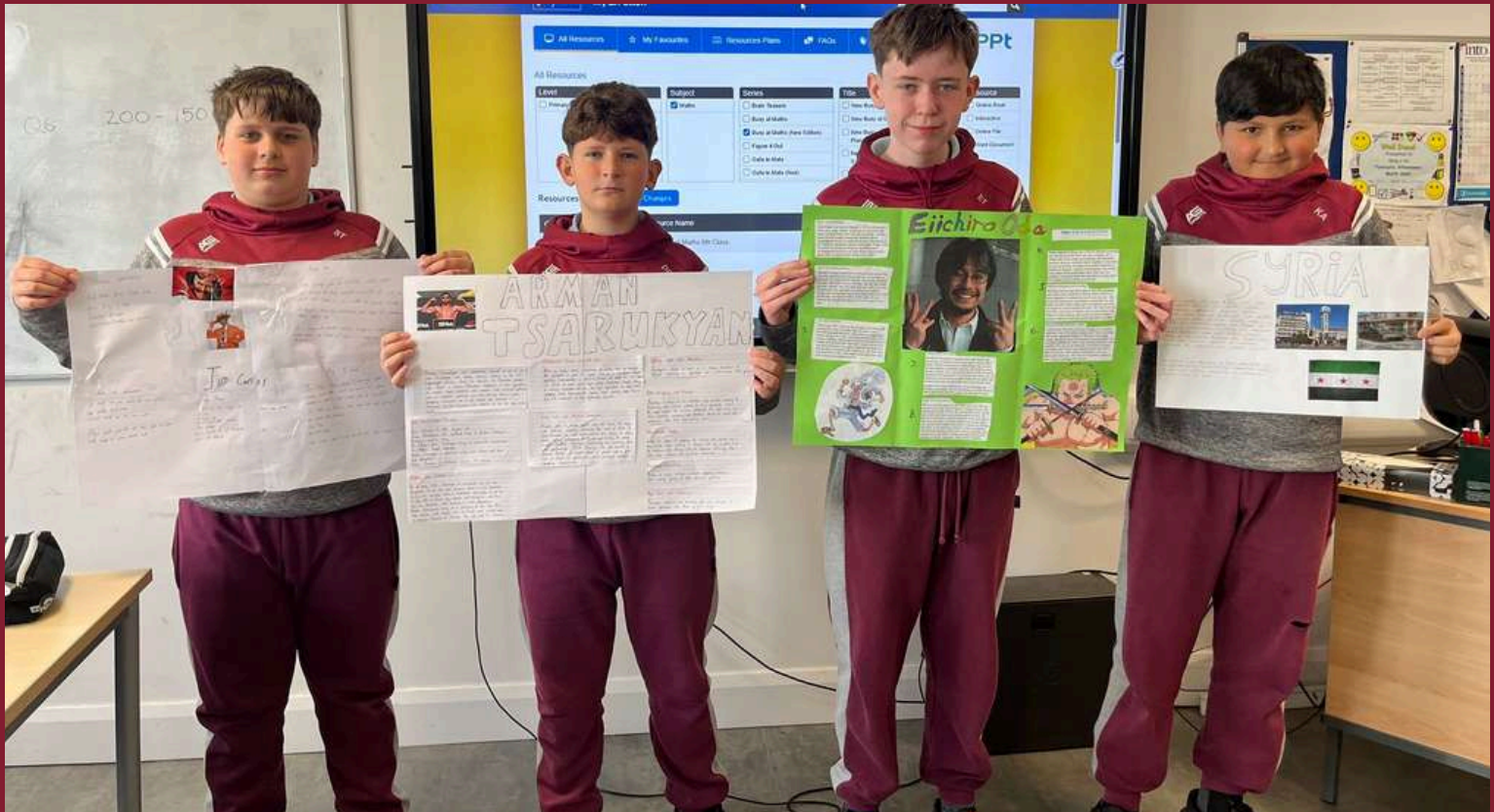
A late basket from Kefrane earned Courtenay a well-deserved draw.

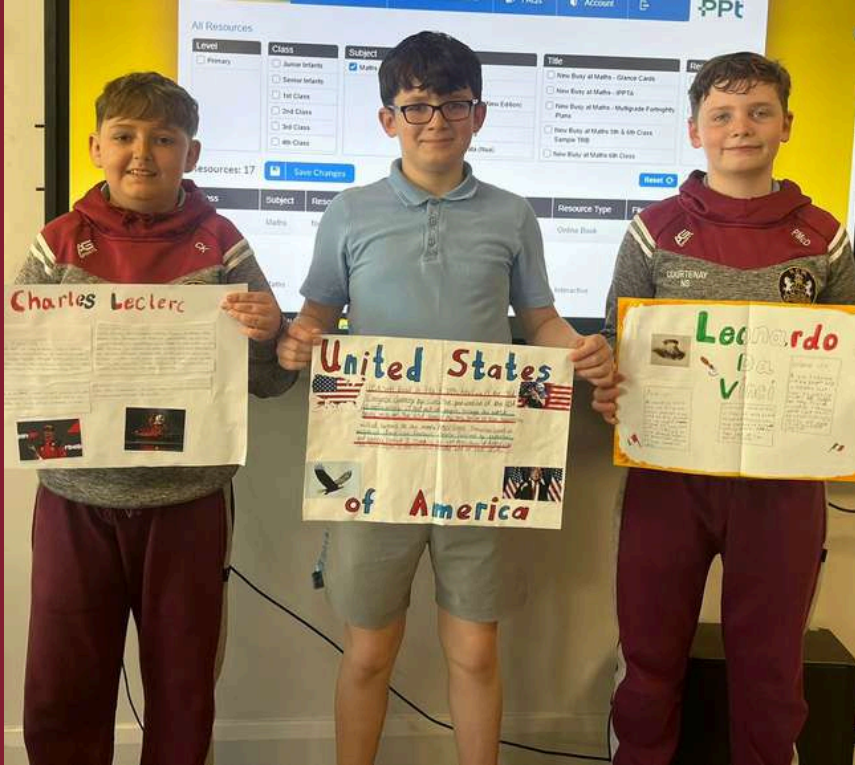
